**DESIST AND REFRAIN ORDER
(For violations of section 31110 of the Corporations Code)**

The California Corporations Commissioner finds that:

1. At all relevant times, Eric St. Andre, also known as Eric Boyd, was a sole proprietor doing business as St. Andre's Automotive Accessories.
2. Beginning in or about June 1998, and continuing thereafter, Eric St. Andre and St. Andre's Automotive Accessories have offered and sold at least one franchise for the operation of an automotive parts and accessories store. The franchisee was required to pay a franchise fee of \$139,000 plus a monthly royalty fee of 5% of the franchisee's gross sales.
3. The franchise was offered or sold in this state.
4. The Department of Corporations has not issued a registration to Eric St. Andre or St. Andre's Automotive Accessories for the offer or sale of any franchise in this state. Additionally, the offer or sale of any franchise of St. Andre's Automotive Accessories is not exempt from registration.

Based upon the foregoing findings, the California Corporations Commissioner is of the opinion that the franchises of St. Andre's Automotive Accessories are subject to registration under the Franchise Investment Law and franchises are being or have been offered or sold without being registered. Pursuant to Section 31402 of the Franchise Investment Law, Eric St. Andre, also known as Eric Boyd, and St. Andre's Automotive Accessories are hereby ordered to desist and refrain from the further offer or sale in the State of California of any franchise of St. Andre's Automotive Accessories, unless and until registration has been made under this law or unless exempt. This Order is necessary, in the public interest, for the protection of franchisees and consistent with the purposes, policies, and provisions of the Franchise Investment Law.
