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**DESIST AND REFRAIN ORDER**

**(For violations of section 25110 of the Corporations Code)**

The California Corporations Commissioner finds that:

1. At all relevant times, Network Services Depot, Inc., d.b.a. Net Depot (NSD) is or was a California corporation, formed in or about March 2002.
2. At all relevant times, 360 Wireless Corp. (360 WC) is or was a Nevada corporation formed in or about October 2001.
3. At all relevant times, Bikini Vending Corp. (BVC) is or was a Nevada corporation formed in or about January 2002.
4. At all relevant times Charles V. Castro, is or was the principal and the control person of Network Services Depot, Inc., d.b.a. Net Depot.
5. At all relevant times Edward Bevilacqua is or was the principal and the control person of 360 Wireless Corp. and Bikini Vending Corp.
6. Beginning in or about November 2001 and continuing to about November 2002, Castro, Bevilacqua, NSD, 360 WC and BVC offered or sold securities in the form of investment contracts comprised of internet kiosk sales, service and management programs.
7. The purported purpose of NSD was to sell internet kiosks and site leases through independent marketing companies and insurance agents, costing between \$5,500 and \$9,000 per internet kiosk.

1 8. The purported business of 360 WC and BVC was to enter into service and management  
2 agreements with the purchasers of the NSD internet kiosks.

3 9. The purchasers of the NSD internet kiosks were to receive a monthly fee of between \$50 and  
4 \$90 plus percentages as high as 33% of the gross revenue when total revenue exceeded a certain  
5 dollar amount which varied from agreement to agreement.

6 10. These securities were offered or sold in this state in issuer transactions. The Department of  
7 Corporations has not issued a permit or other form of qualification authorizing any person to offer  
8 and sell these securities in this state.

9 Based on the foregoing findings, the California Corporations Commissioner is of the  
10 opinion that the investment contracts in the form of internet kiosk sales, service and management  
11 programs offered and sold by Charles V. Castro, Edward Bevilacqua; Network Services Depot, Inc.  
12 d.b.a. Net Depot, Inc.; Bikini Vending Corp. and 360 Wireless Corp. are securities subject to  
13 qualification under the California Corporate Securities Law of 1968 and are being or have been  
14 offered or sold without being qualified.

15 Pursuant to Section 25532 of the Corporate Securities Law of 1968, Charles V. Castro,  
16 Edward Bevilacqua; Network Services Depot, Inc. d.b.a. Net Depot, Inc.; Bikini Vending Corp. and  
17 360 Wireless Corp are hereby ordered to desist and refrain from the further offer or sale in the State  
18 of California of securities in the form of the investment contracts in the form of internet kiosk sales,  
19 service and management programs, unless and until qualification has been made under the law.

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
