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Memorandum of Understanding between

The parties agree as follows:

1. Dollarworks, LLC is added to the captioned case as a Respondent.
2. The California Deferred Deposit Transaction Law license issued to Dollarworks, Inc. is revoked.
3. The California Finance Lender Law license issued to Dollarworks, LLC, was submitted to the Department of Corporations for surrender. In error, the Department accepted the surrender.
4. The Respondents withdraw all pending license applications filed by them with the Department of Corporations
5. The Respondents stipulate that the Complainant could establish a prima facie case to support the allegations set forth in the accusation.
6. The Respondents choose not to present a defense to the charges brought by the Complainant.
7. David Walker agrees that for a period of 10 years commencing on the effective date of the signed stipulation he will not personally apply for either a California Deferred Deposit Transaction Law license or A California Finance Lender Law license nor will he make such an application through any business entity owned and/or controlled by him.
8. After the 10 years have elapsed, should David Walker, whether individually or through any business entity owned and/or controlled by him, apply to the California Department of Corporations for a license, the allegations set forth in the instant accusation shall be deemed to have been admitted.
9. The statements and admissions contained in this agreement are applicable only to the instant case and shall not be used, and the parties do not intend these statements and admissions to be used, as admissions, res judicata, or collateral estoppel in any other action.

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EXHIBIT A

10. The parties intend to draft a formal agreement memorializing this settlement. In the event, the parties are unable to agree upon a formal agreement, this Memorandum of Understanding may be used as the final agreement between the parties.
