- 4. That the applicant will maintain a file of all advertising for a period of 90 days from the date of its use, which will be available to the Commissioner of Financial Protection and Innovation upon request.
- 5. That the applicant will file with the Commissioner of Financial Protection and Innovation an amendment to this application prior to any material change in the information contained in the application for licensure, including, without limitation, the plan of operation.
- 6. That the applicant will file with the Commissioner of Financial Protection and Innovation any report required by the Commissioner.
- 7. That the applicant hereby attests that the applicant (including officers, directors and principals) has not engaged in conduct that would be cause for denial of a license. Only one declaration required for each applicant.
